YouthBank Scotland's training programmes are based on strategic and practical knowledge of youth participation and engaging young people as financial decision makers and organisational leaders developed over 15 years across the UK. Our training enables young people to play active leadership roles in their communities.

Over 500 young people have gained a qualification through YBS accredited training programmes. Our accredited programmes include:

- **Decision Making Skills** One Awards (Formerly OCN) level 2 SCQF (Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework) level 5 one credit
- **Leadership Skills** One Awards level 2 SCQF level 6 one credit
- **Young People's Grant making** One Awards level 1 and 2 SCQF level 4 or 5 one credit, both available.
- One credit equals a notional 10 hours of learning engagement

Beyond grant making

YouthBank Scotland is a youth led organisation that has been engaged by community organisations and national bodies to assist them to explore and improve youth participation in their development and leadership. Bespoke packages have been created for

- Midlothian Youth Platform; leadership and fund raising
- YMCA Scotland; exploring youth leadership roles nationally
- Wishaw Youth Exchange Group; programme development and decision making
- YoungScot; decision making training for young people's panels members
